Organised by Shri Yaduvanshi Education and Charitable Trust, Purusharth Kanya Chhatralaya has been providing free boarding school facilities to girls of all castes for the last two years. It aims to facilitate holistic development through various activities such as living, studying, and engaging in various different activities. The institution is running projects like "Save the Daughter, Educate the Daughter" to make a meaningful impact.



Currently, the institution is operating in rented accommodation but is in the process of constructing a new building for the girls' hostel within the premises of Tapovan Vishwavidyalay on the Barada Hill. This new building will accommodate 250 girls from all backgrounds for their studies. While the children of Tapovan Vishwavidyalay are currently studying in tents, they will soon have access to modern facilities and comfortable amenities for living and studying.

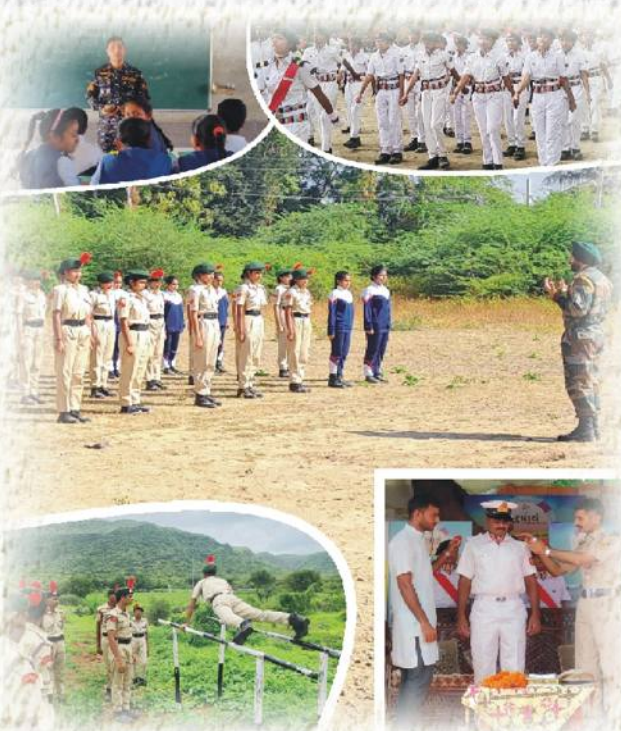
This Tapovan will have separate centres for naturopathy, research library, laboratory, cowshed-based agriculture practice centre, prenatal care centre, indigenous crafts centre, pharmacy, yoga and meditation centre, spiritual practice centre, swimming pool, rifle shooting range, and other various centres. This new construction will directly benefit the students, teachers, parents, and all sections of society.



Tapovan Vishwavidyalay is reconstructing itself to enlighten and preserve our ancient heritage like Nalanda and Valabhi universities, contributing to the awakening and preservation of our culture.

About Purusharth Vidyaniketan, Bhanvad Dist. : Devbhoomi Dwarka

Purusharth Vidyaniketan is an institution based on values and character, where the emphasis is not on financial gain but on the development of exemplary personalities. It is the only institution in Gujarat that operates on a zero budget. Along with the education of students, it also conducts continuous training for parents and teachers, workshops for skill development, and life skills camps. By combining traditional educational practices with new discoveries, it embodies the trinity of education as per the National Education Policy 2020. Meeting various challenges of India and the world, the institution is continuously striving to travel towards higher quality standards.



Experiential Learning:

Here, more than 200 activities are conducted annually. Education is imparted by integrating all these activities with the richest experiences of life. These activities include rifle shooting, swimming, more than 36 sports, music, yoga and meditation, cultural activities, NCC Army and Navy, career counselling programs, excursions, experiments, etc. Through activities like these, international classrooms have excelled in China, Malaysia, Singapore, as well as in National SGFI. Furthermore, they have also made it to the Guinness Book of World Records twice.

Preservation of Cultural Heritage:

In accordance with the National Education Policy 2020, remarkable work is being done in the field of arts and theater to keep the teaching of local history alive in the new generation. Cinematic dramas based on historical events like Veer Mangadavala and other ancient true events of the region, presented multiple times by a collection of child artists, have been witnessed by over 20,000 people.





Addiction-free School Family:

Here, students, parents, and teachers are free from addiction. The code of conduct for admission states that children's parents must be completely free from addiction, and the daughters of addiction-free parents are admitted to the school free of cost. Additionally, it is imperative for teachers to remain addiction-free.

Service (Seva):

Through this organization, 180 girls are provided with free boarding facilities for education, free education for needy children, free distribution of books, distribution of relief books, and distribution of tree saplings. Under the goodwill project, scholarships are provided for higher education, and various service oriented activities such as distribution of grains and clothes to needy people are carried out. Moreover, education and boarding facilities are provided to all children practicing in the ashram without any charge.



"Meet Like-Minded Humans" Encounter Project

(Project of to meet expert of different fields):

Under this project, various experts from different fields, both nationally and internationally, are invited to share their achievements and experiences in their respective fields, allowing children to directly access their knowledge and experience. This project has been operational for the last two years.



About Tapovan University Campus (Bhanvad) "PRADAT" Education System:

Tapovan University does not follow the current Lord Macaulay education system, but rather emphasizes on its original Gurukul tradition-based education system, which focuses on self-learning, self understanding, and self-doing to impart education to children. Here, a unique approach to education is being developed through 10 (ten) types of 'Pras(प्र)(subjects).

Prayer: (प्रार्थना)

Music provides happiness, and when a child embarks on a journey to joy through the prayer session, it enriches the child from within. This beloved prayer aims to cultivate the child's inherent nature and show them the inner vision through its medium.



Nature : (प्रकृति)

Efforts are made to show the inner vision. Tapovan University is being instructed amidst the natural environment of Barda Hills as the best way to educate from nature's perspective. Because humanity is an integral part of nature, all children are encouraged to practice under the open and pure air, witnessing the playful dance of green trees below.



Education: (प्रशिक्षण)

Here, children acquire self-education through the method of self-learning in the lap of nature. In an environment where there are no teachers, no prescribed curriculum, and no traditional examination methods, children develop multiple skills simultaneously based on their own interests through a self-nurtured education system.

Practical Applications: (प्रयोग)

In this institution, most of the educational activities are conducted through practical experiments, including plumbing, agriculture, animal husbandry, technology, pottery, weaving, carpentry, painting, cooking, and management, among other practices, to provide hands-on education.



Travels: (प्रवास)

According to Gijubhai Badheka, education through experiences is like a journey. Through travels, children in this institution not only excel but also gain enriched experiences. These travels include industrial tours, visits to various legal and administrative offices, meetings with bankers, trekking, swimming in rivers, and experiencing flights in planes and helicopters to develop practical skills and gain exposure.



Inclinations: (प्रवृत्ति)

If you tell a child, they may forget, but if you show them, they will remember very well. The creation of a delightful educational experience can be achieved through activities based on the five elements. Only 20% of education is received in the classroom, while 80% is learned outside. Therefore, every step of education here is based on inclinations, such as yoga, meditation, experiments, nature conservation, rural trips promoting freedom from addictions, carpentry, agriculture, and various other labour-intensive activities, comprising a comprehensive system of Tapovan's management and all the activities that take place in regular schools are truly worthwhile.





Questions: (प्रश्न)

When a child does not speak, they are thinking about what we say. Dialogue arises from questioning and counter-questioning, and efforts can be made to stimulate natural curiosity. Tapovan provides an environment where children can easily ask questions.

Events: (प्रसंग)

Through inspirational literature that focuses on values and culture, events can enrich a child's emotional world effortlessly. For this reason, children are exposed to excellent events through reading books, direct dialogues, and event listening conducted by state narrators.



Appreciation: (प्रशंसा)

When a child praises the good work of other children around them, it reinforces their confidence, strengthens them through mutual admiration, and fosters a process of greater development through reciprocal appreciation. Therefore, there is a provision here to always provide children with positive suggestions and feedback.



Progress: (प्रगति)

True progress is when each child advances through small efforts, nurtures small abilities, and strives to achieve small goals. It's not just about marks, careers, jobs, or business education, but true progress for us is education that encompasses all-encompassing and all-encompassing human welfare, education that spreads the fragrance of humanity, education that fosters skills, and education that instils patriotism along with better citizenship.



To achieve these lofty goals, Tapovan's unique "PRADAT" education system is advancing in a significant way. It will continue to be a significant contribution to building a better and brighter nation in the future.

Activities Conducted by This Institution:

1. In 22 years, this institution has provided free education to needy students, amounting to approximately Rs. 5,25,13,000/- (five crore Twenty five lakhs thirteen thousand rupees).
2. Camps are organized for the development of the institution's teachers and staff, with an annual budget allocated of Rs. 2,51,000.
3. The Managing Director is allocated Rs. 1,00,000 for visits to various institutions and for attending camps.
4. Teachers who work at this institution for one year are directly recruited by schools within a 100-kilometer radius without needing to go through an interview process.
5. All staff members of the institution are free from addictions and are never seen at Paan shops or fast food stalls.
6. The institution has been celebrating the sports festival since 2003 and every year gets first rank at district level sports event.
7. The "Save the Daughter" awareness program was initiated in 2003 and provide free education to them.
8. Special scholarship schemes are offered for girls through the "Educate the Daughter" fee relief program.
9. Seminars on organic farming and cow-based agriculture have been conducted since 2005.
10. Former students visit the school on 200 out of the 365 days in a year.
11. Students who complete their 12 years in the school are given a free trip to Ahmedabad and Gandhinagar by plane.
12. Many students have completed their studies after staying in the hostel for up to 10 years.
13. Despite not owning a single vehicle, around 500 children commute from outside to study.
14. In 22 years, not a single vulgar program has been conducted; all cultural programs are inspirational.
15. Scholarships are provided to needy students for higher education after completing the 12th grade.
16. Blood donation camps are organized and Free blood is provided to patients in need.
17. Since 2021, sisters who have served the institution for more than 3 years are given a dowry.
18. Nine teachers are trained at this institution have started their own schools.
19. Parents who are economically weak and quit addictions are granted partial fee waivers.
20. After a certain number of years, employees can determine their own salaries.
21. Over 200 different activities are conducted in the school throughout the year.

22. Additional facilities such as the Children's University affiliated Vidya Niketan since 2013.
23. The annual school calendar with yearly planning is provided every year.
24. Experienced and qualified teachers who are free from addictions.
25. Training for Army and Navy is provided from the 8th grade.
26. Facilities like a computer lab, laboratory, rifle range, swimming pool, and sports are available.
27. A large modern (computerized) library with 20,000 books.
28. Classrooms for music, dance, handicrafts, creative arts, yoga, and special free classes for weak students.
29. A modern studio for learning skills like advertising, news, and music, a planetarium, a science gallery, and a skating place (planned in the near future).
30. Hostel facilities for both boys and girls.
31. Hostel facilities for staff members.
32. Guesthouse facilities for visitors.
33. Daily morning evening Havan (Yagya) and Vedic mantra recitations.
34. Spiritual environment and playground for sports.
35. Entire campus equipped with CCTV cameras (since 2003).
36. Education from 1st to 12th grade in Arts, Commerce, and Science streams in the Gujarati medium.
37. A Balbhavan for children aged 3 to 5 years.
38. The school achieves the best results for grades 10th and 12th.
39. In the year 2022-23, (100) girls, in the year 2023-24, (130) girls and 2024-25 (180) girls are provided completely free hostel facilities.
40. Many awards has been received for the excellent work.

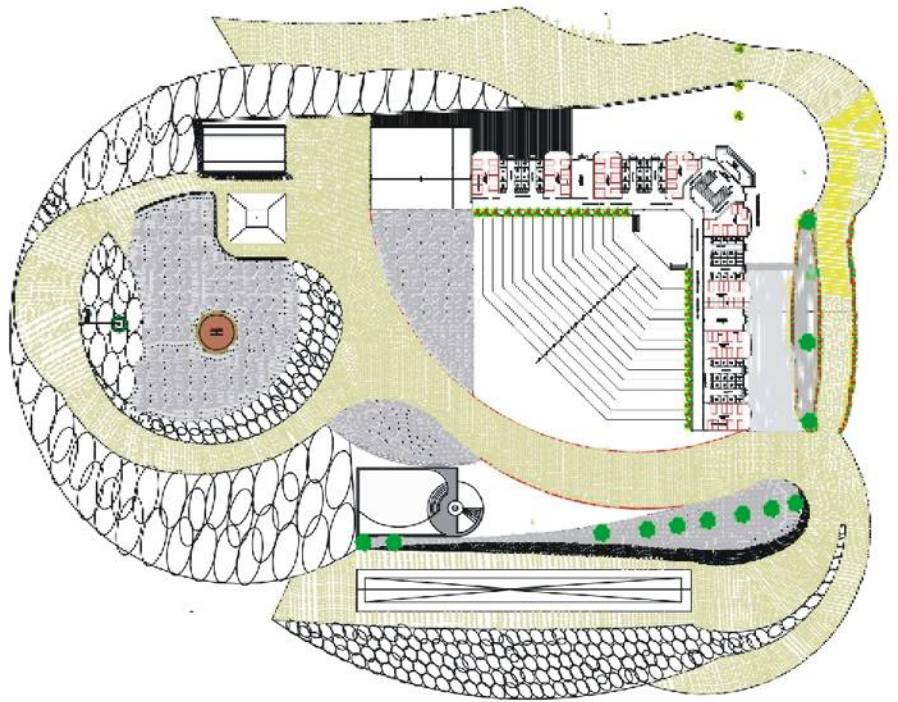
